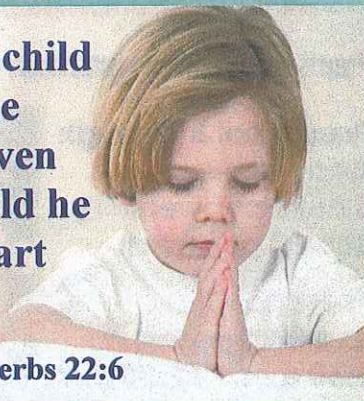

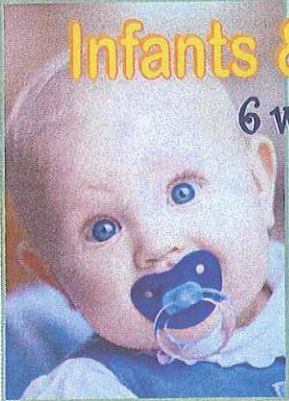

1 & 2 24-36 months

Our curriculum encompasses thematic planned activities that encourage growth in language, social, cognitive, spiritual and motor development with daily exposure to early academics and creative play.



Preschool 3 Year Olds

Our curriculum continues to encompass thematic units with a center based approach. Phonetic awareness, pre-writing and writing skills, pre-reading, letter recognition, sequencing, art, math, science and social studies, and Bible lessons.

Bridging 4 Year Olds

Kindergarten preparation includes our thematic, center based curriculum rich in language development, phonics, whole language, letter recognition and blending. Math skills including number recognition, sequencing patterning and estimation. Hands on social studies, theme related science activities, and Bible lessons.

Social and cognitive development are assessed for 3 and 4 Year olds biyearly with parent-teacher conferences conducted.

After School Pre-K~5th Grade

Children are picked up at 5 area schools. Homework assistance, nutritious snacks and time for gross motor and social development are included. Holiday care available during the school year.

Summer Camp Elementary

Theme based weeks with coordinating activities and projects with related field trips and guest speakers are included.
